PLANNING MEETING
JUNE 03, 2019

The Ashland City Council met for a Planning Meeting on June 03, 2019 at 5:30 P.M. in the Ashland City Hall Auditorium with Mayor Larry J. Fetner presiding. Council Members present were Billy J. Smith, Kim M. Cain, Annette F. Gaither, and Tommy Cantrell. Also present were City Clerk/ Administrator Chelsey Wynn, Assistant City Clerk/ Court Clerk Robin Catrett, Police Chief Joseph Stanford, Maintenance Supervisor Lester Robinson, Fire Chief Brett Thompson, Patrol Officer Adam Otwell, and Tammy Andrews.

Council Member Bobbie J. Steed was absent.

Items discussed included a date for the First Responders Dinner, regular meeting agenda additions, CDBG grant applications, storm shelter grants, and the eviction of a tenant on city owned property.

Assistant City Clerk/ Court Clerk Robin Catrett updated the Mayor and Council on the progress of the Revenue Discovery Service offered through Avenu Insights and Analytics. Assistant City Clerk/ Court Clerk Catrett advised the program has generated \$9,808.80 in revenues that the city would not have received otherwise.

Assistant City Clerk/ Court Clerk also reported on behalf of Youth Sports Coordinator Ben Bailey. Mr. Bailey advised the 8U Boys Tournament will be held on Thursday, June 06, 2019- Monday June 10, 2019 at Northside Ballfield and the T-Ball Field. Mr. Bailey invited everyone to attend the tournament. Mr. Bailey also thanked the Mayor and Council for the support and thanked the Maintenance Department for their work in preparing the fields and concession stand for the tournament.
